The Saint Ignatius Wildcats Swimming Team invites you to compete in the 47th Viking Swimming Invitational on Saturday, December 18, 2021. Please note that the format has changed with the A&B sessions combined into one morning session. There will be ABC finals in all individual events other than the 500 free which will be A finals only. Relays will be timed finals with A relays swum during the finals session and B relays swum during the prelim session. The meet will be scored.

Swimming Meet Format:

Prelims / Finals:

The total number of entries will be limited based on the timeline. Swimmers will be accepted in the order they are received.

- Relay Events Two (2) team entries per relay event. Relays are timed finals.
- O B-Relays will be swum in Prelims.
- O A-Relays will be swum at Finals.
- O Relay cards will be distributed at the beginning of Prelims (B-relay) and Final (A-relays) warm up. They should be completed and taken to the block at the time of the swim.
- O Participating in a relay will count towards an athlete's 4 event limit.
- O Swimmer must be listed in the meet database to be eligible for a relay event.
- Bonus Events: A swimmer qualifying for one individual event has the option to participate in a second "bonus" event provided the swimmer meets or exceeds the bonus standard. The 500 freestyle is not an eligible bonus event.

The 500 freestyle may be <u>limited to the four (4) fastest-seeded heats per gender.</u> Swimmers excluded from the top 4 heats will be offered the option of entering a different event on a space available basis and provided they meet that event's time standards.

- ABC FINALS: Top 10 will advance to Championship (A) finals, next 10 fastest will advance to Consolation (B) finals and next 10 fastest will advance to Bonus (C) Finals in all individual events except for the 500 free which will have Championship (top 10) finals only.
- There will be a 15 minute break following the 50 Free.

<u>Time Standards:</u> All qualifying swims must have occurred between the start of last year's Swim Season (11/1/2020), and the meet closing date Friday, December 3, 2021.

<u>Proof of Time:</u> We reserve the right to refuse entries by teams that abuse the qualifying times. A team that has an excessive number of athletes not making the time standards in events will be asked to prove entry times. If proof cannot be provided, invitations to future Viking Meets may be withheld.

<u>COVID Protocols:</u> All Federal, State, County, and CSU requirements effective at the time of the meet will be in place. CSU currently requires all persons in the building to wear a face mask. Swimmers should bring a plastic container or Ziplock bag to hold their masks while they are swimming.

When the total number of entries reaches the meet capacity, notification of the official meet closure will be sent to all registered teams and posted on Lake Erie Swimming and Swimmeet.com. No further entries will be accepted after this announcement.

Entry Deadline: Sunday December 5, 2021

- <u>All entries (electronic plus hard copy) and payments</u> must be in the hands of Julie Bare by **11:59 p.m. on Sunday, December 5, 2021**. Please retain a hard copy for your records.
- Times may be updated until December 10, 2021.
- Teams are responsible for paying for their entire entry regardless of athletes actual participation in the meet. *No refunds are given for missed events and absent athletes*.
- Checks payable to: **St. Ignatius High School Athletic Department.** Please mark the name of your school on the memo line.
- <u>After December 5, 2021</u> no changes to entries or events will be accepted other than updated times. There will be no deck entries.

<u>Late Payment:</u> Each team is required to pay their entry fees by December 5, 2021. Failure to pay by December 11th may affect future invitations to the Viking Swim and Dive Meet. *Late fee of \$25* will be added to the total invoiced amount to teams submitting payment after the deadline.

<u>Awards</u> must be picked up by the winning athletes or their coaches at the meet. Relay teams, please try to come as a group. Girl and Boy "Performer of the Meet" will be selected based on the highest NISCA power point total of two individual events.

- Top **six (6)** swimmers in individual event
- Top <u>three</u> (3) teams in relay events.
- "Performer of the Meet" 1 Girl and 1 Boy
- Top Team Award 1 Girls Team and 1 Boys Team,

Meet Rules:

<u>Waivers Are Required for each swimmer:</u> You must provide the appropriate *signed* waiver for each swimmer. These will be collected at the meet entry table.

- Cleveland State University Participant Release and Waiver of Liability form for each swimmer.
- Parent's Consent form If the swimmer is under the age of 18 years

Scratches

Swimmers who qualify for Championship Finals, Consolation Finals or Bonus Finals are expected to swim unless they scratch. If they do not intend to swim in the evening, they will have thirty (30) minutes after the announcement of qualifiers for a particular event to declare their intention to scratch at the official's table. This is not a championship meet. Swimmers may withdraw from prelim or final with a Declared False start.

Notes from the Referee:

- We will be following the swimming rules as dictated by the Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA).
- A meeting for all coaches will be held before the start of warm-ups at 6:45 a.m. near the pool office where you checked in.
- At check in, you will receive heat sheets and meet rules. Because it will be a crowded event, it is our hope that your athletes will comport themselves respectfully, keep their area clear of debris, and be watchful of their belongings. Please discourage swimmers and divers from bringing valuables on deck.
- Scratches will be accepted at the scoring table within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the coaches meeting.

No additions. Once the meet starts, declared false starts (DFS) will be accepted by the referee. Swimmers not showing for their event will be disqualified from that event (3.2.3.1)

- We will be doing dive-overs during the preliminary session for all events using the forward start. Please make sure you tell your swimmers to remain in the pool until after the next heat has started. Also, there will be a 15-minute break after the Boys 50 free.
- Finals will take place in ten lanes in each individual event. Bonus (C) and Consolation (B) Finals will preced the Championship (A) heat and will be conducted in all individual events other than the 500 free which will have A finals only.
- Swimmers not intending to swim in the finals session must notify the scoring table no later than 30 minutes after the event results have been announced.

Regarding USA-S observation

The meet has been approved for USA-S observation. The meet will be a "blanket" observation but swimmers need to have their full legal name, date of birth and USA Swimming membership number entered in your meet file or pick up the necessary forms at the scoring table and submit it to the Referee *before* the start of warm-ups. Times for relays (all swimmer must be on the same USA-S club), lead swimmers of relays or initial distances MUST be arranged ahead of time with the referee (See the attached forms).

This form must include the swimmers USA ID and the full legal name and birthdate of the athlete. Forms without the USA ID cannot be processed. Please make your own duplicate copies as required. Swims to be observed must have a reasonable chance of meeting USA Swimming Championship, National, World Cup sectional or U.S. Open qualifying standards.
